The Visitor Information Specialist will deliver exceptional customer service by greeting and engaging with visitors, providing recommendations for their visit to Hoyt Arboretum, and assisting them with retail purchases. The Visitor Information Specialist is an in-person role that requires availability on weekends and holidays from May through October.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Visitor Services:

 - Answer questions and offer recommendations for visiting Hoyt Arboretum and other cultural institutions around Washington Park
