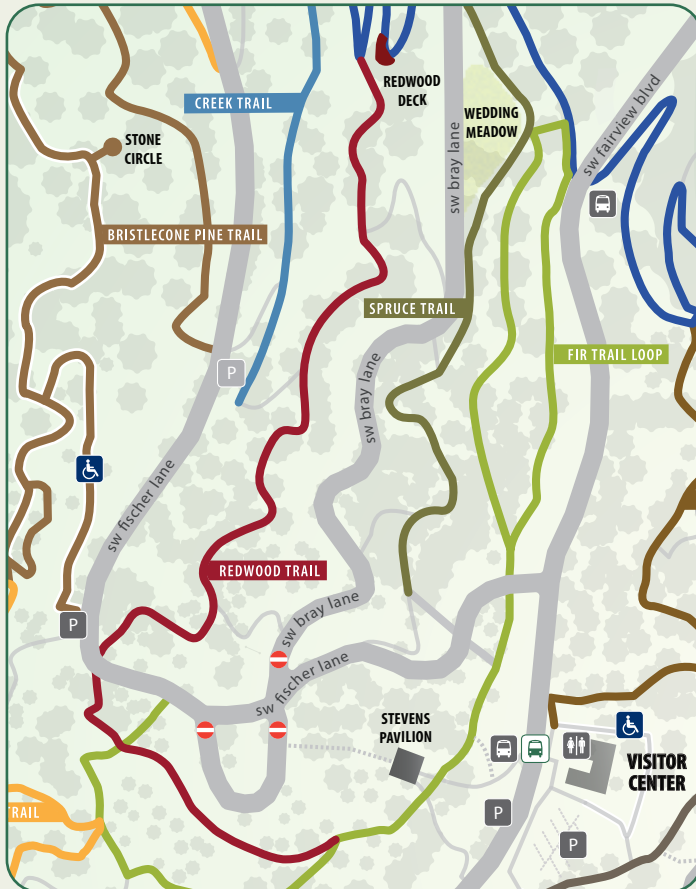

EVENT RENTAL REGULATIONS

- Hoyt Arboretum is smoke and tobacco free.
- Alcohol at permitted events only.
- Hoyt Arboretum is a quiet park; sound producing equipment is not allowed.
- Parking spaces cannot be reserved and are not guaranteed.
- Attaching anything to trees or driving stakes into the ground is prohibited.
- A permit must be obtained for any legal union ceremony in a public park when guests are invited. This includes ceremonies consisting of more than the couple, officiant, and two witnesses.
- Bubbles are the only thing approved for showering the wedding couple; rice and birdseed is prohibited.
- Capacity limits and other rules for events might change due to COVID-19. Please visit portland.gov/parks/covid-19-updates for the latest information.

Hoyt Arboretum has four beautiful outdoor spaces close to downtown Portland available for weddings, picnics, retreats, and other events for groups up to 100 people.

STEVENS PAVILION

Capacity: 100 people

Rental Fee: \$595.75

Full-Day Rental: 8:00 AM–9:00 PM

The iconic Stevens Pavilion is a wooden A-frame structure open on all four sides to views of towering Douglas-firs. The picnic shelter is a great setting for company picnics, family gatherings, and other special events, but it is especially popular for Portland weddings. The Pavilion has 10 permanently affixed picnic tables (6 under cover) that cannot be moved and is ADA accessible. Located across the street from the Visitor Center, drinking fountains, and restrooms. 110-volt electrical outlets at the site.

REDWOOD DECK

Capacity: 40 people standing, 25 people seated

Rental Fee: \$300.00 (\$485.00 with Wedding Meadow)

Half-Day Rental: 8:00 AM–2:00 PM or 3:00 PM–9:00 PM

The Redwood Deck is an open wooden platform with three permanently affixed benches that offers a serene getaway for intimate gatherings. Nestled in a redwood grove, the Redwood Deck is a popular location for wedding shoots, intimate weddings, and other small gatherings and is located off the Wildwood Trail about 1/3-mile from the Visitor Center. The Redwood Deck is not ADA accessible, but there is nearby site access via Bray Lane. The Redwood Deck can be rented in conjunction with the Wedding Meadow for the natural contrast of deep forest views and open green space. No electricity, water, or restrooms at the site (located at Visitor Center).

WEDDING MEADOW

Capacity: 100 people

Rental Fee: \$285.00 (\$485.00 with Redwood Deck)

Half-Day Rental: 8:00 AM–2:00 PM or 3:00 PM–9:00 PM

The Wedding Meadow is a rustic, wooded glen that offers the feel of wilderness near the city center. A peaceful, grassy setting surrounded by tall conifers and fringed with white-blooming shrubs, the Wedding Meadow is located at the junction of the Spruce and Fir Trails about ¼-mile from the Visitor Center. The Wedding Meadow is not ADA accessible, but there is nearby site access via Bray Lane. The Wedding Meadow can be rented in conjunction with the Redwood Deck. No electricity, water, or restrooms at the site (located at Visitor Center).

STONE CIRCLE

Capacity: 40 people, 6 chairs

Rental Fee: \$204.00

Available for 2-Hour Blocks: 10:00 AM–12:00 PM,
2:00 PM–4:00 PM, and 6:00 PM–8:00 PM

The Stone Circle is accessible via a short walk on the paved Bristlecone Pine Trail. With a backdrop of towering conifers, this location offers a quiet forested setting for small ceremonies and is perfect for the couple that wants the feeling of the deep woods with the convenience of a city park. No electricity, water, or restrooms at the site (located at the Visitor Center).
